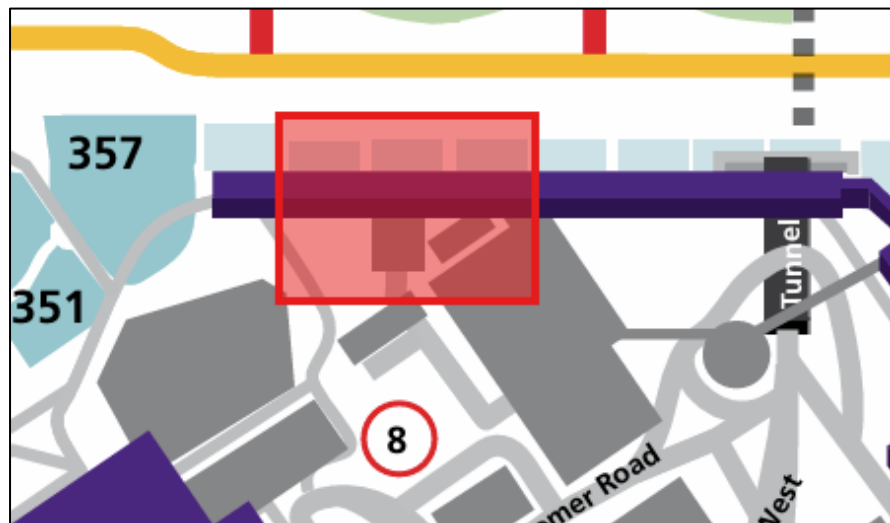
Operational Advice Notice

Pier 4A Nightly Road Closure

Aer Lingus Lounge Demolition

1. Introduction

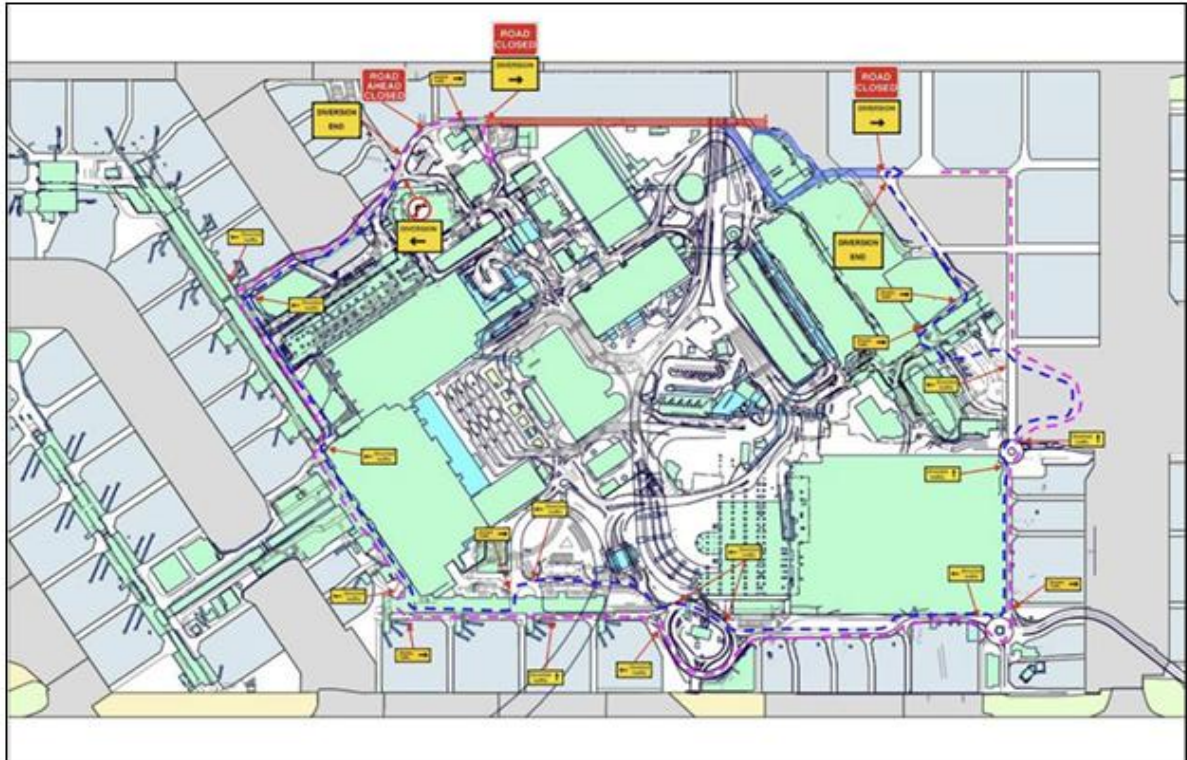


- 1.1 This Operational Advice Notice (OAN) informs the community of urgent works required to demolish the Aer Lingus lounge and nightly road closures required to support the works.
- 1.2 The road along Pier 4A in Terminal 1 will close nightly from **Monday 29th June to Thursday 2nd July (inclusive)** from **22:30 – 04:30 (local)**.
- 1.3 There will be a traffic management system with signage in place to assist with traffic diversions in the area, as per **Drawing A** below. Drivers must always adhere to the speed limits and signs displayed. Outside of the above-mentioned hours, the road will be reopened to full operations.



- 1.4 This OAN should be read in conjunction with OAN 473, which also covers the nightly closure of this area for a different project.
