



Going to the CTA?

Cycling into the CTA is currently not possible, due to the closure of the tunnel side bores. Colleagues with Heathrow ID can park their bikes at PEx (Eastern Perimeter Road) or N4 (Northern Perimeter Road) and use the free colleague buses to T2 and T3. Bus times are available on the Airport Community App (Travel to Heathrow section).

Alternatively, park at the Cycle Hub and use the Hotel Hoppa buses from the Renaissance Hotel to T2 and T3 (Heathrow ID holders can travel free in both directions). Or park at T5 and use the free trains and Tube (approx 05:00-24:00).

Speed on flat terrain (average cyclist) = 18 km/h
1km = approx. 3 minutes and 30 seconds
Allow extra time for crossing roads

No designated cycle track along this section of the Southern Perimeter Road - cycling on the main carriageway is not recommended (40mph speed limit)

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- Cycle track (off carriageway)
- Toucan crossing (no need to dismount)
- Cycle lane (on carriageway)
- On carriageway (with reduced traffic flow)
- Bus lane (can be used by cyclists)
- Pedestrian route (useful connections)
- Cycling prohibited
- Control Post
- Cycle parking and the number of spaces
- Café
- First Aid
